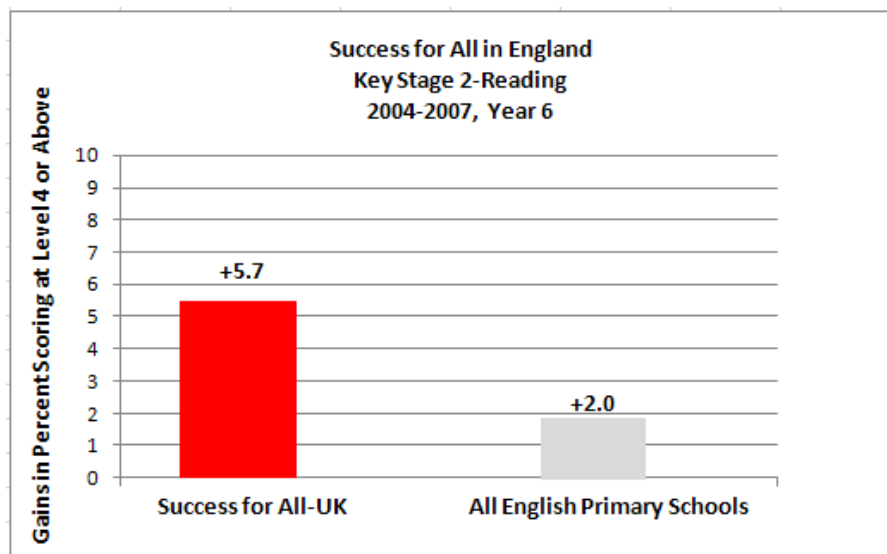


Success for All Primary Schools in England Gain on Key Stage 2 Reading

Schools throughout England using the Success for All reading programme once again made significant gains on Key Stage 2 reading assessments. **From 2004 to 2007, Success for All schools increased by 5.7 percentage points the number of pupils achieving Level 4 and above.** Other schools in England gained 2.0 points.

Schools making particularly outstanding gains include:

- St. Andrew's C of E Primary in Lambeth: 49%
- Muschamp Primary in Sutton: 39%
- St. Stephen's C of E Primary in Lambeth: 38%
- Taylor Road Primary in Leicester: 35%
- Cayley Primary in Tower Hamlets: 21%
- Manor Oak Primary in Bromely: 18%
- Broadacre Primary in Hull: 15%
- Bude Park Primary in Hull: 15%
- Cleeve Primary in Hull: 15%
