St Andrew's Primary School 2007

was the 6th most improved school in the country in 2007. They achieved 86% level 4 and above in their KS2 SATs in 2007.

Webster Primary School November 2007

A recent innovation has been the use of the 'Success for All' programme, which is giving a strong focus to meeting pupils' needs in literacy.

Manor Oak Primary School November 07

The school have successfully introduced a structured English scheme operating by ability rather than age so that pupils who arrive at school with low levels of English can slot in at the appropriate level.

Hamp Community Junior School September 07

Recent curricular initiatives, including the Success for All literacy programme, are beginning to improve pupils' progress. The new literacy programme has been effectively introduced and is encouraging pupils to develop good cooperative and listening skills.

Hamp Nursery and Infant School May 07

The successful teaching of a recently introduced phonics programme is having an immediate and discernible impact on raising standards in reading and writing.

In Years 1 and 2, the teaching of phonics is very successful in raising standards, increasing the proportion of pupils achieving Level 2B and above in national assessments.

Nightingale Primary School February 07

Achievement is now satisfactory overall, and pupils achieve well in reading and writing. This is because of an intensive programme that focuses on teaching the basic skills and very carefully tracks the progress of each child, so that no one slips through the net.
